The research assistant's task will include helping iRisk researchers in preparing, designing, programming and implementing experiments and surveys; analyzing survey, observational and textual data; conducting literature reviews and other pertinent research activities.

The ideal candidate will have the following background, skills, and experiences:

- A background in economics, psychology, and/or applied math
- Coding experience in Python, R, Stata or other languages
- Interest in behavioral economics, economics & psychology, and/or experimental economics
- Strong project management and communication skills in spoken and written English

The position is ideally suited for students who would like to improve their research skills to prepare themselves for graduate school.

The start date is September 1, 2022, or later.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree by start date

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND DEADLINE: Applications should include (i) a cover letter that explains motivation and prior experience, (ii) an informative CV that lists degrees, research experience and software skills, (iii) relevant course transcripts and grades, and (iv) one or two reference letters.

We especially encourage women and members of underrepresented minority groups to apply. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis until the position is filled. Only shortlisted applicants will be notified.
